Year 5 will learn the ukulele during a weekly session led by our music teacher from One Education, Jules Kent.

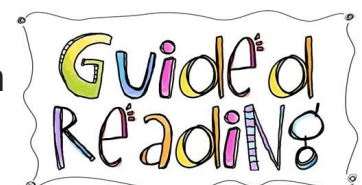

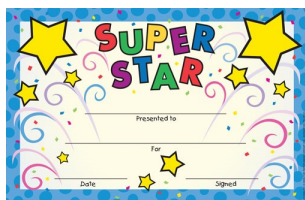
